BELGIQA VENEER PLANKS

001 PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The Belgiqua veneer planks bring warmth, depth, and continuity to any space. These MDF planks with a veneer finish are specially designed for walls and ceilings, offering a refined, natural look. Together with the Belgiqua veneer panels and Belgiqua flexible veneer, they form part of the 360° concept and create a perfectly balanced whole within any interior.

001 GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Each Belgiqua veneer plank is built from two layers of real wood veneer with a sturdy 12 mm MDF core in between. Belgiqua planks can be used for both residential and commercial applications and are available in different wood types, gradings and colors.

Gradings Oak: Rift Mixmatch, Mixmatch, Natural Grade, ART Grade

Gradings Forgotten wood species: /

Dimensions: 3050 x 150 – 180 – 220 – 260 – 300 x 13 mm

Thickness: MDF 12 mm, veneer 0,6 mm

Compositions: Top layer of real wood veneer stained and UV protected with color oil, applied sequentially by means of a rolling technique and intermediate curing; a core of MDF with a high density of 700 kg/m³ (±50 kg/m³) and a backing layer of veneer.

Bonding: The HPLT (High Pressure Low Temperature) press procedure used by Belgiqua guarantees the best quality for each plank. The process follows the DSI-method, ensuring complete saturation of the wood fibers and a significantly tight bond.

Applications: Belgiqua veneer planks are best suited for interior applications and easily fit into any commercial, retail, hospitality or residential project. Common applications include wall and ceiling cladding.
